ALL IN ONE gives us an insight into the visual universe and understanding of the pictures by artist STEPHAN WITTMER. His picture themes deal with being on the go and of the constant change, which seems threatening for most people.

The exhibition project at ESSZIMMER thinks ahead of the physical space of photography, by questioning classic presentation modes, which are broadened in their installation.

To show photographs as art pieces in a room, the artist deals with the materiality of them. He develops new approaches and strategies of intervention, which lead to concentrated installation moments. WITTMER creates pictures on the wall, in the room and around us. The own and the foreign perception blend together, and their distinctness is retrieved again in a symbiotic unison. Whether physically or mentally, for STEPHAN WITTMER it is always about the perceptible, photographic space.

The artistic practice of STEPHAN WITTMER is shaped through his curatorial and publishing activities: In addition to his works, the bundle of the previous issue of the Magazin _957 will be presented, which celebrates its 10-year existence and represents an important part of STEPHAN WITTMER'S works.

AUDIO EVENT Thursday, May 12th 2022, 7pm

During the exhibition, the premiere of an electronic composition of JOACHIM ZOEPF takes place. The composition deals with Adorno's speech *Kultur und Verwaltung* from 1959 musically as well as textual.

With analogue modular- and digital technology, JOACHIM ZOEPF quotes individual phrases Adorno's and breaks them down ironically. Furthermore, music excerpts from the 60s and sounds are brought to life and processed. An electronical piece is produced, which tries to captivate listeners through a steadily growing flow of the composition and improvisation's dialectic.

JOACHIM ZOEPF is a musician, sound engineer, composer, and organizer. He lives and works in Erfstadt/GER. From 1979 he studied saxophone in Wien, then in Köln. He is a freelance musician and music teacher since 1983, and has worked since in free improvised music, originating from mainstream and free jazz ever since 1988. In the last few years, JOACHIM ZOEPF has also been creating artistic videos.

In addition, he is co-founder of Arbeitsgemeinschaft Improvisierte Musik (AIM), the series Leitkultur, the sub-lable Improvisers Series and co-organizer of Symposium's Improvisierte Musik in Köln, as well as co-editor of the book "Können Improvisatoren tanzen?".
